Product Description: Continuum Explorer is a browser plug-in for Chrome that allows developers to quickly evaluate web content for accessibility issues that can be detected automatically in the browser in real-time during development.

Notes: Testing was performed on Microsoft Windows 10 PCs with Google Chrome and Firefox.

Evaluation Methods Used: Evaluation of Continuum Explorer involved a combination of manual and functional testing. Level Access (Level) comprehensively tested a selection of pages representative of Continuum Explorer using a testing methodology that is aligned with the Web Accessibility Conformance Evaluation Methodology 1.0. Assistive technology, including a screen reader (JAWS), screen magnification (ZoomText), and speech recognition (Dragon), were used along with exclusive use of the keyboard, manual inspection of code and review of Accessibility API output to determine support for the WCAG success criteria.
